EVACUATION PROCEDURE FOR COCKBURN ICE ARENA

IN THE OF AN EMERGENCY AN ALARM WILL SOUND. AN APPROPRIATE / QUALIFIED STAFF MEMBER WILL NOTIFY ALL STAFF AND PUBLIC THE URGENCY OF THE SITUATION AND THE NEED TO EVACUATE. EMERGENCY LIGHTS WILL COME ON IMMEDIATELY AND ALL STAFF WILL BEGIN CHECKING ALL AREAS TO ENSURE THE BUILDING IS EMPTY OF ALL PERSONS.

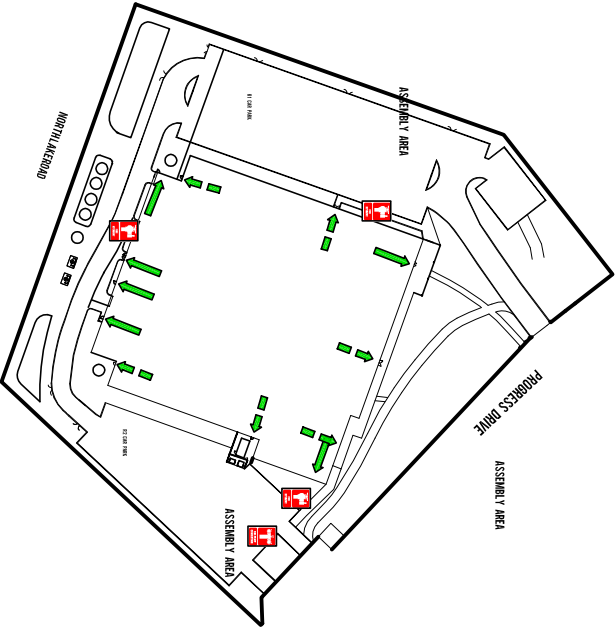
STAFF WILL INDICATE THE BEST METHOD TO EXIT THE BUILDING, HOWEVER ALL EMERGENCY DOOR EXITS WILL LIGHT UP.

ALL STAFF AND PATRONS WILL BE ASKED TO CONGREGATE AT A SAFE PLACE OUTSIDE THE BUILDING SO ALL PERSONS MAY BE ACCOUNTED FOR.

COMMUNICATION WITH STAFF AND PUBLIC WILL BE MADE VIA TWO METHODS

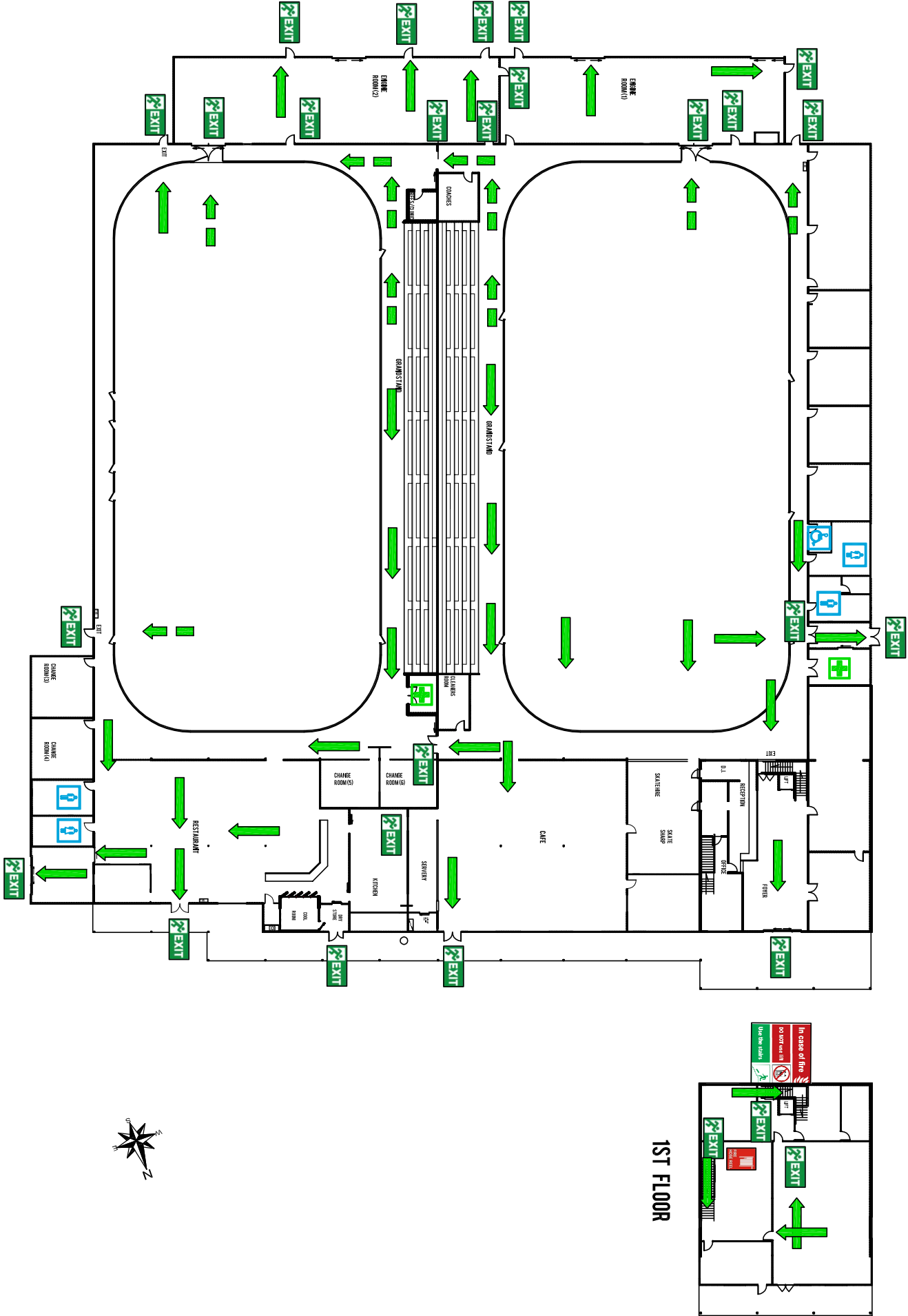
1. LOUD SPEAKER SYSTEM


